





Workshop 2 – Hungarian University of Agriculture and Life Sciences (Gödöllő, Hungary)

Accommodation

In the pictures above you can see what the hotel looks like. However, entrance to the reception is not as straight forward. To reach the reception, you have to enter the courtyard of the hotel through the main square passageway (arrow at the top right picture). The reception is located at the farright side (arrow on the bottom left picture).

Arrival

For colleagues that will be arriving by car, I guess the process is rather straightforward. Once you arrive to the hotel, it has an underground garage. You can park your cars there and proceed to register.




For colleagues that will be arriving by train, you will arrive to the (one and only) main train station of Gödöllő (labelled blue). Once you arrive, you will have the University campus on one side, and a large park on the other side of the station. You should head towards the park (it's facing the front side of the station). Once you cross the road, you should head through the park, you will see only one walkway leading through it. The hotel (labelled red) will be at the other side of the park. The address of our Institute is 'Páter Károly u. 1', however, this is the address for the whole campus, not just our Institute. And the Institute is not in the main University building. The best way to find our building is to put into Google Maps the following:



To help further, I have made a small screenshot from my phone. The arrow on the bottom of the picture shows where you will be entering the campus from the train station (this is the closest way from your accommodation). You can proceed to the main University building (labelled with red), and once you get to the main entrance, go right. When you hit the road, turn left, and continue upwards. Once you reach the end of the road, you will go right, and you will see a construction site where the new Church is being built. Once you get to it, go left, and straight towards our Institute. The track I suggested is labelled with the orange/golden line. Anyway, a colleague of mine will pick you up at the hotel and will take you to the Institute building the first time.









Travel to Budapest (during free time)

In addition to the tour we will have on Monday, all participants are free to visit Budapest during free hours as I guess most of you will be interested ©

For the participants with a car, it's again straightforward. As for parking, I usually park at the Arena Mall as it is not expensive, and it is right next to the Keleti train station, so you will have many connections from there.

As for the participants going by train, you can get to the train station as described above. Trains go from Gödöllő to Budapest Keleti train station (and vice versa) very frequently. From Gödöllő to Budapest they go 4 times during each hour of the day. The two going on the 6th and 36th minute of every hour are 10 mins faster than the other two. Same for vice versa; they go 4 times each hour from Budapest to Gödöllő; ones going on the exact hour and 30th min of every hour are the faster ones.

Once you get to the Keleti train station, you will have plenty connection to everywhere. I'd suggest you use the two metros (M2 and M4) as they cover Budapest very well. If you want to go to the city center, the best would be to grab the M2 metro and exit at Deák Ferenc tér. The Parliament building is on the same metro line, just one stop after – Kossuth Lajos tér. The Buda castle can be reached from Deák Ferenc tér by grabbing bus number 216 (but there are other options as well). If you are interested in visiting something else and are not sure how, please let me know and we'll figure it out. But in general, Google Maps works perfect
